Welding, cutting or grinding steel generates and sparks, fumes and small particles that can cause a worker to be impacted by an:

- Ignition source
- Contaminated atmosphere
- Airborne high velocity debris

Hot Works.

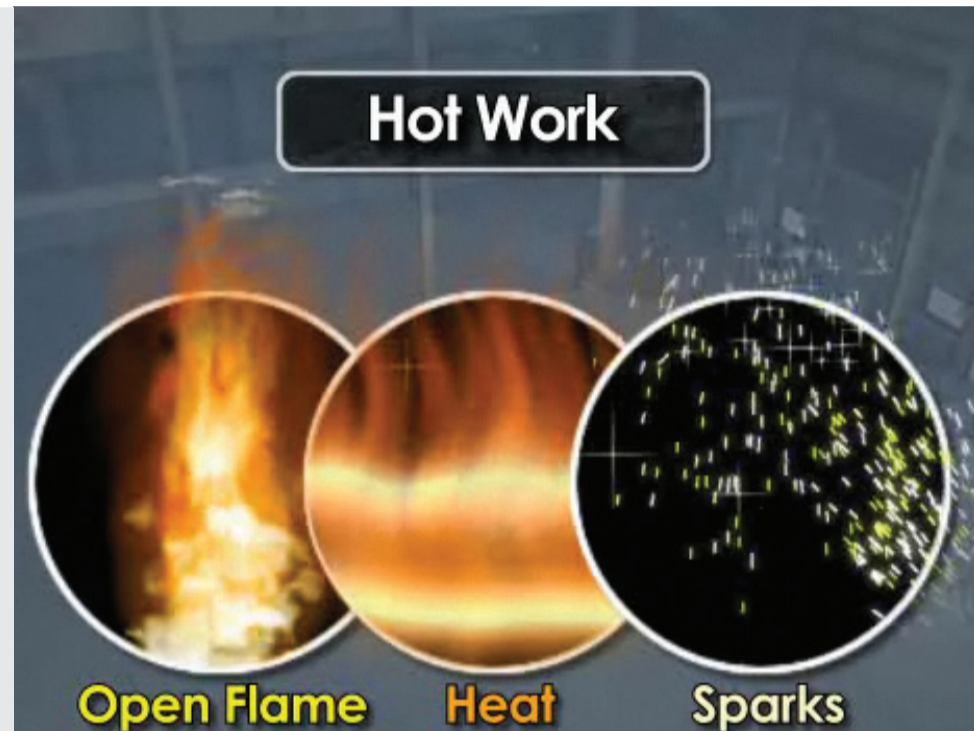
Fires are a real hazard for any construction site.

Hot works are any works that produce an ignition source. Examples include:

- Creating sparks from Welding, Cutting or Grinding Steel.
- Processes or equipment that produces a consistent heat

Hot works permits.

A hot works permit is required for all hot works. Only persons performing hot works are to be in the hot works zone. Work permit controls must be in place before starting any hot works. A fire watch must be in place for at least 60minutes after the completion of hot works.
